Worthy Sir Knights,

Spring is almost here... the season of new beginnings. The weather will becoming milder, and the sun will be out longer. The Birds will be a lot more active, and the

By the time you receive this Edition of the Meadowland Patriot, Ash Wednesday will be behind us, and we will be well into the 40 days of our Lenten season. This most holy of seasons is marked by prayer, fasting, abstinence, and penance. While Easter will mark the end of the Lenten season it is the true beginning, a renewal. Consider what these 40 days means to us as Worthy Sir Knights.

First of all, this time of temptation took place immediately after Jesus was baptized by John. And though Jesus Himself did not spiritually need that baptism, these two series of events teach us so much. The truth is that we as Worthy Sir Knights choose to follow Christ and live out our baptism, we receive a new strength

to fight evil. The grace is there. As a new creation in Christ, you have all the grace you need to conquer the evil, sin and temptation. Jesus, therefore, set for us an example in order to teach us this truth. He was baptized and then was driven into the desert for 40 days to face the evil one so as to tell us that we also can conquer him through our faith.

As Jesus was in the desert enduring these temptations, "the angels ministered to him." The same is true with us. Our Lord does not leave us alone in the midst of our daily temptations. Rather, He always sends us his angels to minister to us and to help us defeat our enemies that are tempting us.

Perhaps it's a temptation of the flesh, or a struggle with anger, self-righteousness, dishonesty or something else. Whatever your temptation may be, know that you have all you need to overcome it on account of the grace given to you by your Baptism, strengthened by your Confirmation and regularly fed by your participation in the Eucharist.




Fr. Bismarck has asked that we share within the Knights and ask those wishing to attend to register by using the QR code provided on the attached flyer.
